We identified some talented girls and who love singing. We have mobilized them to meet as often as possible to make singing practice. We foresee a music band that

would be formed by our talented teen moms. This band, besides tapping and nurturing talents, it may become one of our BTM CBO source of revenue in future. We dream to obtain basic musical instruments for the girls that are already meeting to sing.



On March 3, 2025, we were privileged to host Mrs. Elizabeth Achieng, a professional music teacher and vocal coach who committed to occasionally come and train our girls on vocals. From the one day session Mrs. Achieng had with our girls, she recognized that they have the potential to become good singers. We desire to continue supporting them to the best of our capacity. We hope to start sharing their songs soon on our Youtube Channel. We continue to dream for greater possibilities.

Recognizing that teen moms struggle with self-esteem, we believe that ongoing guidance may encourage them to believe in their abilities and embrace their potential, both as young women and as parents.
